The Municipality of Ayer's Cliff is looking for 3 to 5 citizens to sit on its Environmental Advisory Committee (EAC).

Description of the Committee

The role of the EAC is to submit recommendations to the Municipal Council regarding studies and analyses carried out at the request of the latter, concerning the environment, water, air, soil, energy, residual material management and sustainable development. He or she may also issue, on his or her own initiative, opinions and recommendations on issues directly related to the mandate given to him or her by Town Council.

Profile sought

Candidates must:

- have significant expertise and/or interest in environmental and sustainable development issues (e.g. environment, biology, geography, hydrology, etc.)
- be a resident of Ayer's Cliff;
- have good interpersonal skills and have a good sense of teamwork;
- Demonstrate integrity and open-mindedness;
- Be available for a minimum of 4 meetings per year, on weekday evenings;
- Good knowledge of the Ayer's Cliff territory and its realities are assets.

❖ Duration of the mandate and remuneration

The duration of the mandate of the members is set at two years from the date of their nomination. The mandate of each member may be renewed by resolution of the Council.

Remuneration shall be fixed for attendance at each duly convened meeting.
