

JOB OFFER Environmental Technician - student job

The Municipality of Ayer's Cliff, part of the Memphremagog MRC in the Eastern Townships, is looking for a student to fill the position of Environmental Technician for the summer of 2022.

Responsibilities

<u>Under the authority of the Building and Environment Inspector, you will have to perform various tasks related</u> to the environment such as:

- Prepare and conduct inspections of waterfronts to assess their compliance with the current Zoning By-law;
- Completing follow-up reports in order to present a summer assessment of the general state of the shorelines on the territory;
- Carry out investigations and research in connection with environmental complaints or following inspections;
- Carry out inspections in the context of tree cutting requests;
- Evaluate the conformity and issue inspection notices when measuring septic installations;
- Inform and educate citizens on applicable environmental standards and their relevance (receiving calls, questions from citizens in the field, etc.);
- Participate in events related to the environment and in the development of awareness tools;
- Monitor and evaluate noxious plants and invasive alien species (IAS);
- Supervise ongoing work sites, particularly for erosion control and compliance with mitigation measures;
- Performs any other related tasks, in conjunction with other members of our team.

Requirements

The desired candidate must:

- 1- Be a Canadian citizen between the ages of 15 and 30 (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- 2- Have or be working towards a college diploma (DEC) in a relevant scientific field (Environment, Biology, Urbanism, etc.);
- 3- Mastery of Office Software (Word, Excel, Outlook, Powerpoint);
- 4- Fluency in French, both written and spoken, and fluency in English;
- 5- Possess a valid driver's license and a vehicle;
- 6- Demonstrate autonomy, organization, initiative, thoroughness, integrity, tact and judgment in the management of files;
- 7- Demonstrate excellent teamwork and customer service skills;

Conditions

- 1- Competitive salary according to the level of experience and qualifications;
- 2- Full time student position (seasonal) of 30 hours/week, for a period of 9 at 12 weeks (to be determined).
