### **Working committee - Salary of Elected Municipal Officials**

The municipality of Ayer's Cliff is looking for four (4) citizens to sit on its working committee concerning the updating of the salaries of the Council Members.

#### **❖ Description of the committee**

The committee under the direction of Me Abelle L'Écuyer-Legault, Director General, has the role of submitting a recommendation to the Municipal Council concerning the updating of the salaries, allowances and other expenses granted to the elected officials within the framework of the application of the By-law Salary of the municipal elected officials no.2020-08. He or she may also issue, on his or her own initiative, opinions and recommendations on issues directly related to the mandate granted to him or her by Town Council.

#### **❖ Profile sought**

Candidates must be residents of Ayer's Cliff. It is not necessary to have specific skills to become a member of the committee. Only interest and motivation are required!

The committee members will have to show integrity and objectivity. Indeed, they must not have any family or other relationship with an elected official that could affect their impartiality. They must also make themselves available for meetings (maximum of 3).

#### **❖ Duration of the mandate and remuneration**

The term of office will end with the issuance of a recommendation to Town Council regarding the salaries of elected officials. The projected length of the term is a maximum of three (3) months. It is anticipated that between one (1) and three (3) meetings will be held as required.

**No remuneration** is provided for the attendance and involvement of members at committee meetings. Participation is on a purely voluntary basis.
